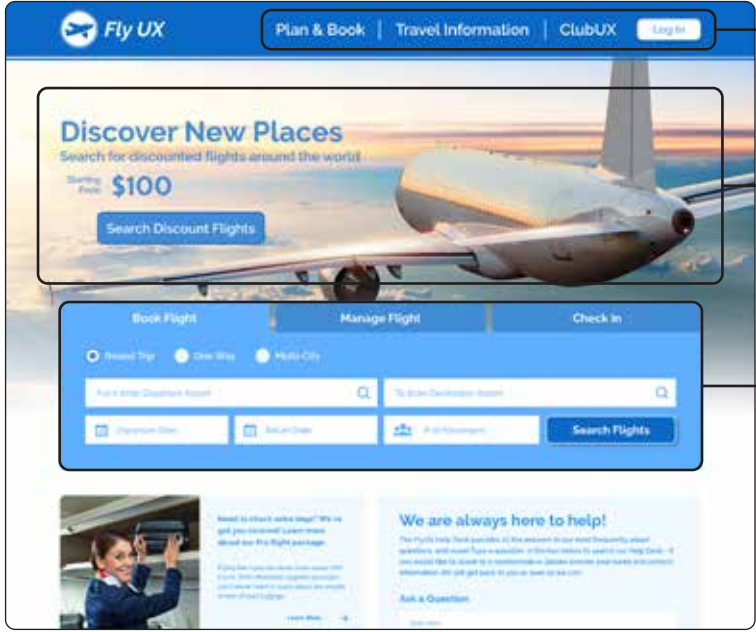


Home Page & Flight Search Interface



Navigation

- Links to each of the main sections of the website and allows users to log in.
- Hovering over each word triggers a drop-down menu w/ sub pages.
- 'Log In' button takes user to login page.

Slider

- Cycles through offers and promoted material.

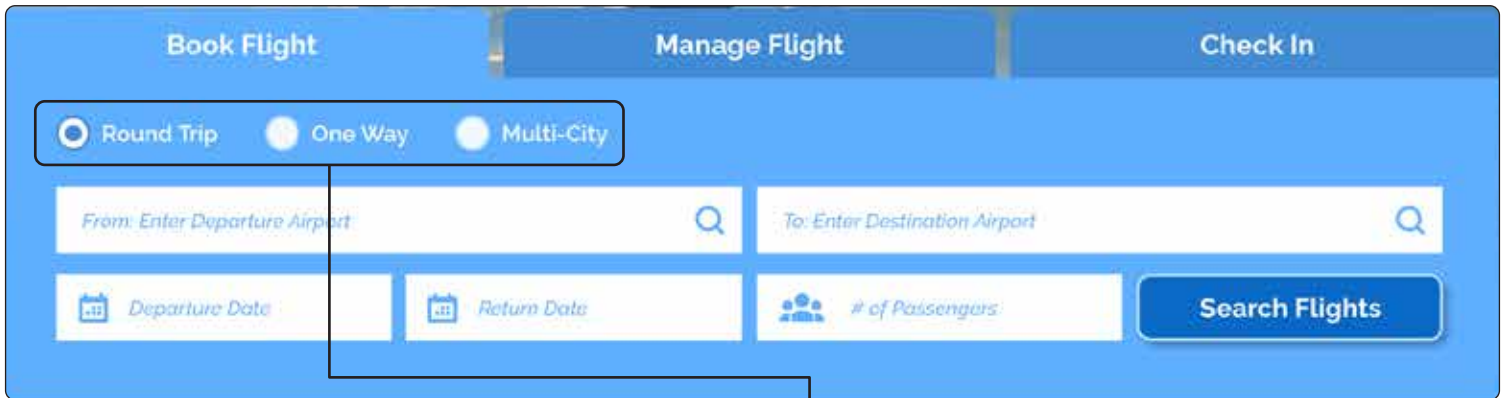
Booking Interface

- Contains 3 tabs: "Book Flight", "Manage Flight", and "Check In".
- Active tab color matches the interface, while inactive tabs are darker.

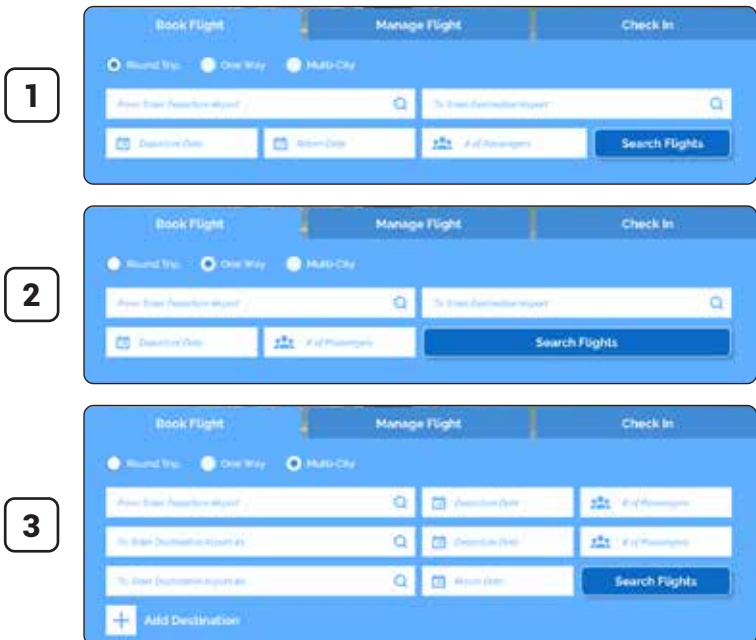

Flight Search Interface - Book Flight Tab - Trip Format

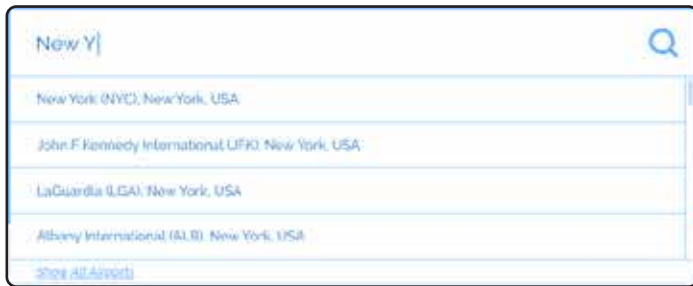


Trip Format

- Radio Buttons (3 Choices)
- The input fields are laid out differently for each choice, and change automatically once a format is selected:
 1. Round Trip
 2. One Way
 3. Multi-City
- The fields remain identical; however, some may be duplicated or omitted when necessary for the search.



Flight Search Interface - Book Flight Tab - Airport Search Fields



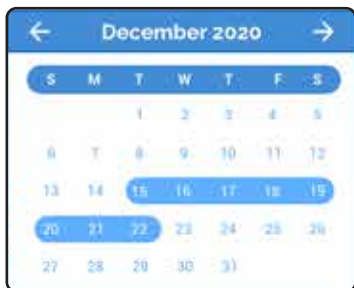
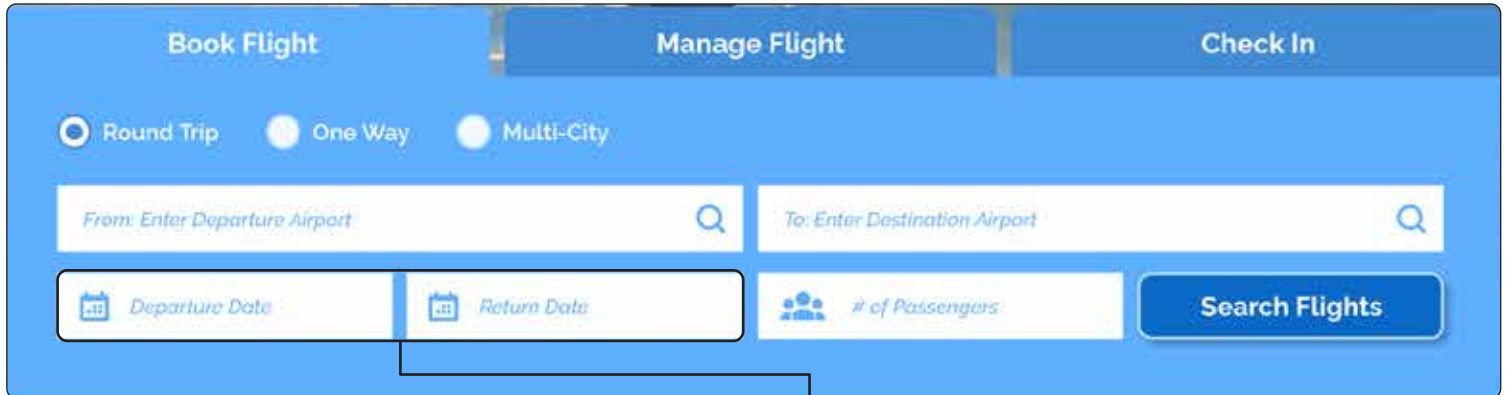
Airport Search Fields

- Text field w/ drop down auto-complete options.
- Both airport search fields work the same, but record two different airports.

Drop Down List

- The drop down list displays relevant airports in order of popularity.
- List window shows up to 5 airports, allowing users to scroll down to see more.
- "Show All Airports" removes the relevancy filter and displays all airports in the list.
- Hovering over an airport highlights it.

Flight Search Interface - Book Flight Tab - Date Fields



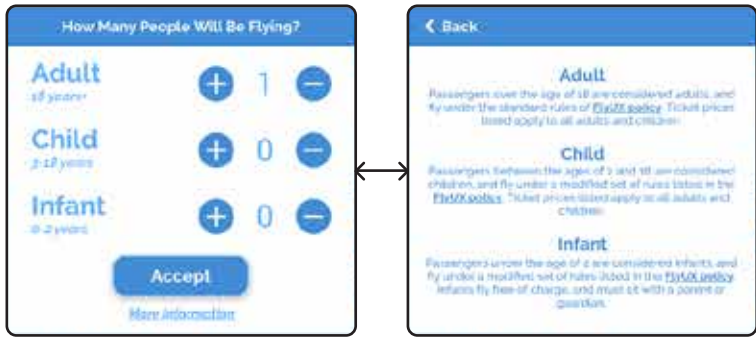
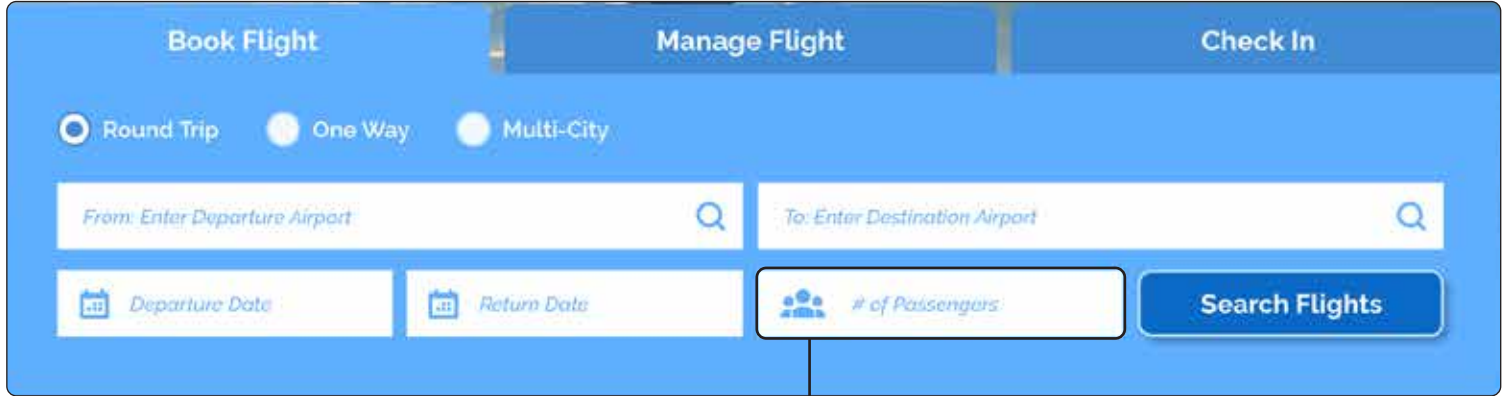
Date Fields

- The date fields are text fields using the format DD/MM/YYYY.
- Once the text field is activated, a drop down calendar appears below.

Drop Down Calendar

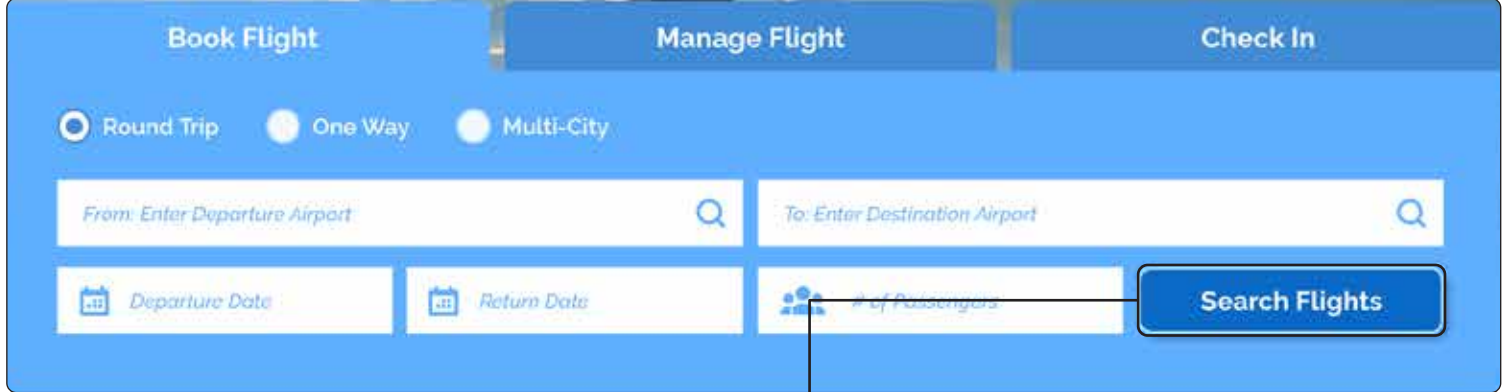
- Calendar defaults to the current month and year.
- Clicking on the month shows all months for that year.
- Choosing a date highlights it, and upon selected the return date, all dates in between are highlighted.

Flight Search Interface - Book Flight Tab - Passenger Field



- Passenger Fields**
 - Activating this field prompts the user to add or subtract passengers to their trip
 - Default value is "1 Adult".
- Drop Down Passenger Menu**
 - (+) and (-) buttons allow the user to add or subtract from each age group.
 - Clicking on "More Information" shows details about each age group in the same drop down window.
 - Clicking "Accept" updates the Passenger field to reflect the user's selection.

Flight Search Interface - Book Flight Tab - Search Flight Button



- Search Flight Button**
 - This button can only be clicked once all fields have been completed.
 - If the fields are not complete before clicking, highlight the incomplete fields.
 - Clicking this button after completing all fields will perform a search and load a new page.

Flight Search Page



Navigation

- The main header items are condensed into a 'Hamburger' menu button.
- A 'User' button gives users the option to log in or access their account.
- Each step of the booking process is displayed with a progress bar. Once a new step is reached, that step's box is filled in with a darker blue.

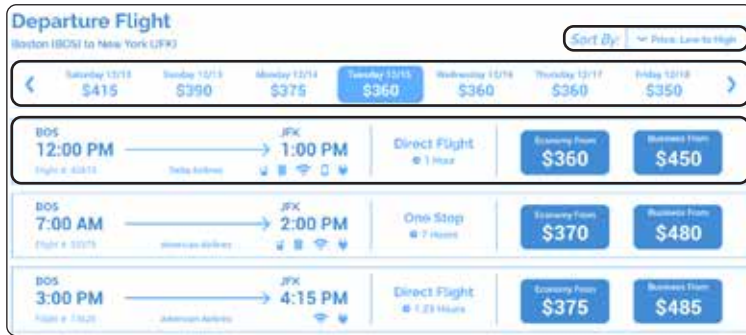
Sticky Header

- This header sticks to the top of the page.
- It displays the search credentials specified by the user, as well as the total cost of the currently selected trip.
- The "Edit Flight" button takes the user back to the flight search interface.

Flight Display & Selection

- Each flight the user has searched for has its own selection interface.
- The user can sort the list accordingly and change the date of the flight.
- All tickets that fit the search credentials for that day are listed.

Sorting Drop Down

- Clicking the button triggers a drop down list that allows the user to choose how their flights are sorted.

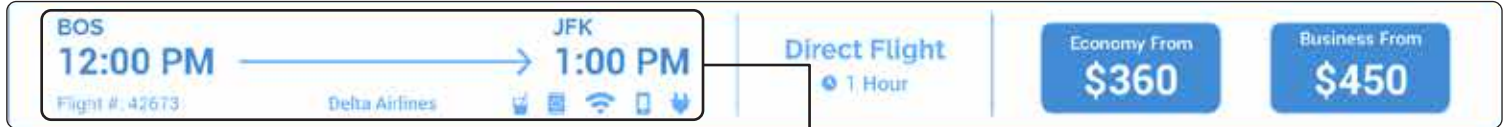
Calendar Bar

- The date selected by the user search is displayed, as well as the 3 previous & future dates.
- The prices displayed below the date are the lowest available ticket price for that day.
- Clicking the arrows shifts the calendar by 1 day in the respective direction.

Flight Details & Package Selection

- Flights are displayed in the order specified by the Sorting Drop Down.
- All relevant information about the flight is displayed for each available flight.
- Each flight is broken down into Flight Details, Travel Details, and Ticket Packages.

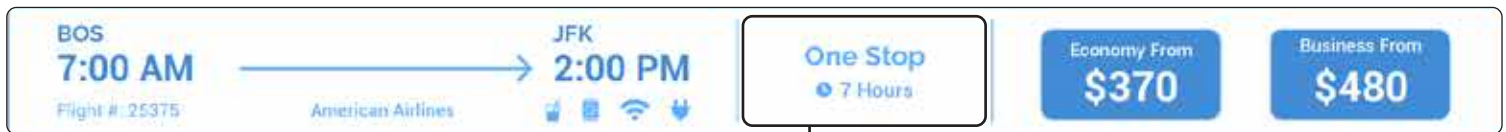
Flight Search Page - Flight Selection Interface - Flight Details



Flight Details

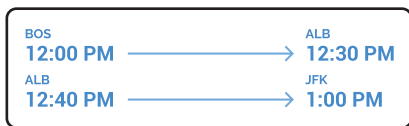
- The airport abbreviations are displayed above the initial take-off and landing times.
- In the bottom row, the flight #, airline, and accommodations are listed.
- Accommodations are represented by icons while the flight # and airline are simple text.

Flight Search Page - Flight Selection Interface - Trip Time



Stops & Trip Time

- Hovering over this section displays the entire flight log, including any layovers in the trip.
- The amount of time displayed is the estimated total time between initial take off and arrival at the destination.



Flight Search Page - Flight Selection Interface - Package Selection



Ticket Packages

- There are two types of Ticket Package: "Economy" and "Business". One button for each category, displaying the "Standard" ticket price.
- When the user clicks on a package button, the interface expands to show the Travel Packages.
 1. The selected ticket package darkens (#286BB4) and top text changes.



Travel Packages

- There are three types of Travel Package: "Standard", "Pro", and "Elite". One button for each displaying the actual ticket price and perks for each category.
- The bottom text links take the user to their respective informational pages.
 2. Once a Travel Package is selected, the entire interface for that flight contracts to only show the selected flight.



Flight Search Page - Flight Selection Interface (Post-Selection)



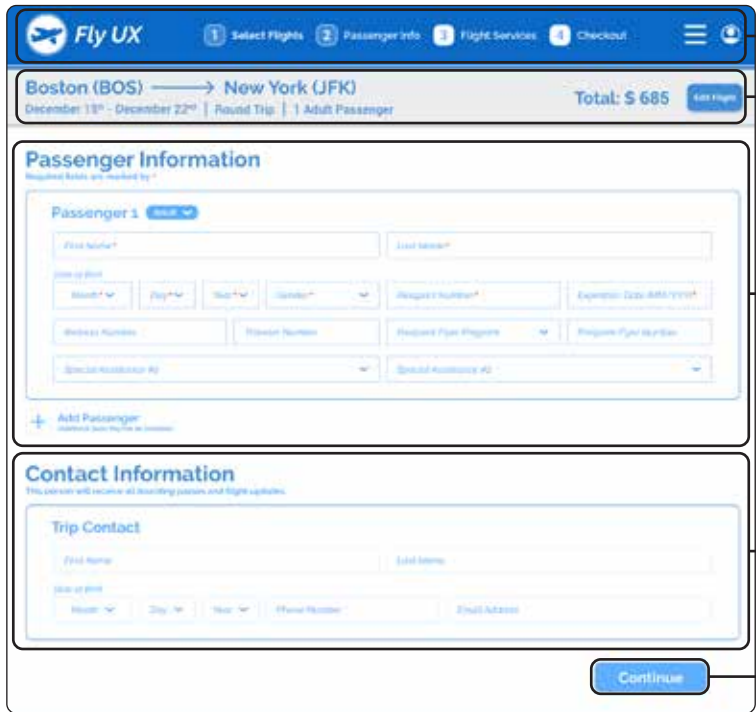
Expand Flight Selection Interface

- Clicking this button expands the Flight Selection Interface to its previous state, showing all available flights.

Log In & Continue Buttons

- The "Log In" button prompts the user to enter their email and password before continuing to the next page.
 - The "Continue" button takes the user to the next page without logging in.

Passenger Information Page



Navigation

- Progress bar updates to step 2.

Sticky Header

- Price total updates to reflect the flights chosen on the previous page.

Passenger Information

- Text and drop down fields to collect information about each passenger.

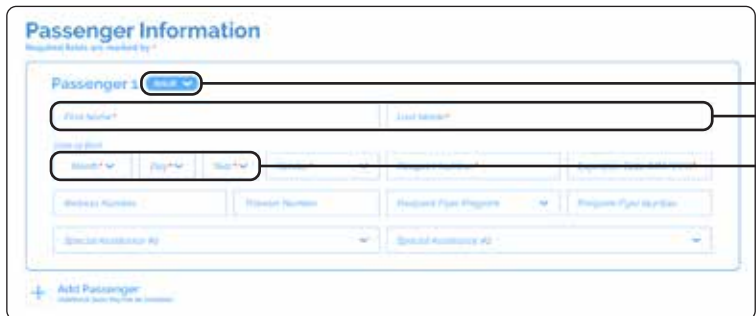
Contact Information

- Text and drop down fields to collect information about the main contact person for the trip.
 - All information regarding the trip is sent to this person.
 - If the user is logged in, auto-populate this section with their account details.

Continue Button

- Button is not able to be clicked until all required fields are complete.
 - Once the required fields are completed, this button will darken (#70A9DC).

Passenger Information Page - Passenger Information



Age Group

- Drop down button that allows users to change/select the age group of the passenger.
 1. Drop down list

Name Fields

- Text fields for both first and last name.

Date of Birth Fields

- A drop down list for the month, day, and year of birth.
 2. Month list
 3. Day list
 4. Year list



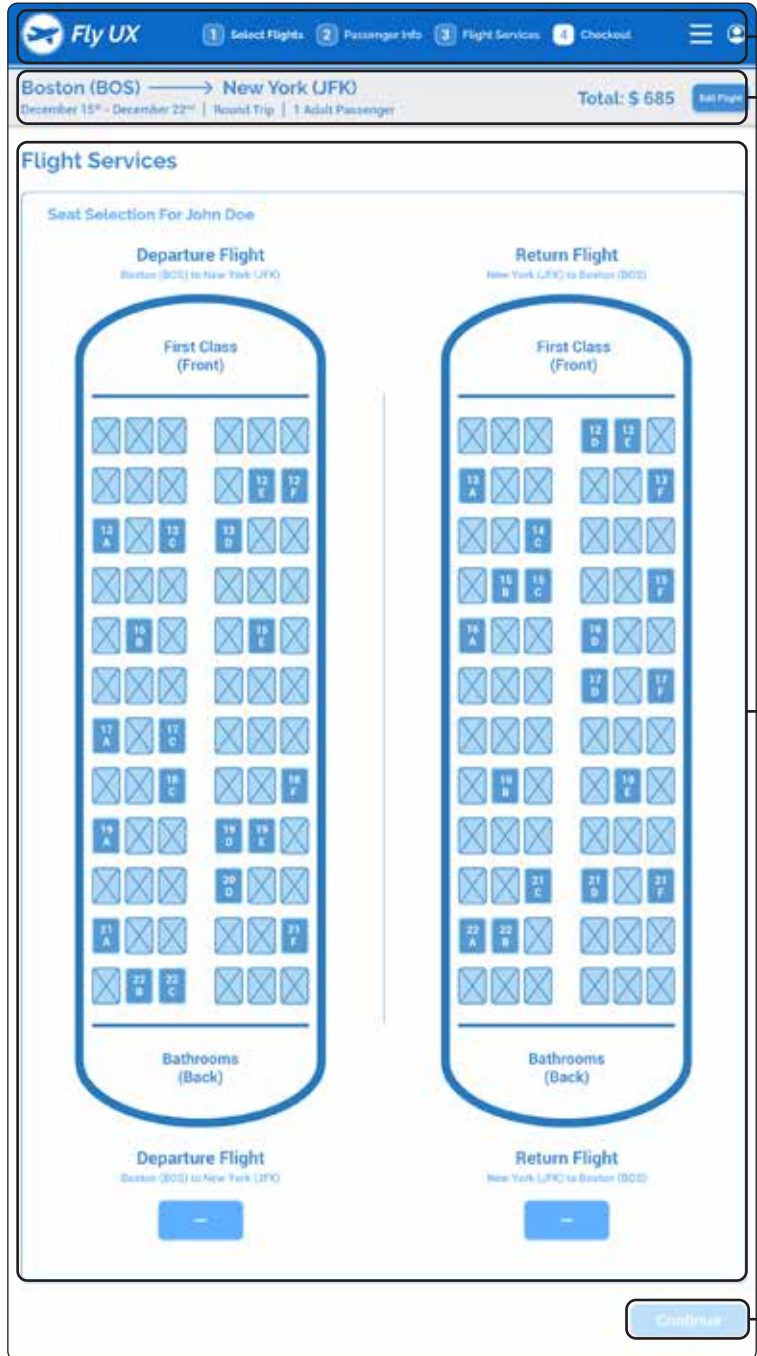
Passenger Information Page - Passenger Information

- Passport Fields**
 - Text field for passport number.
 - Text field for expiration date (MM/YY/YYYY)
- Travel ID & Frequent Flyer Fields**
 - Text Fields for "Redress Number", "Travel Number", and "Frequent Flyer Number".
 - Drop down list for "Frequent Flyer Program".
- Special Assistance Fields**
 1. Drop down list for special assistance options
- Add/Remove Passenger Buttons**
 - When the user clicks the "+" button, an additional passenger is added to the list.
 - When the user clicks the "-" button, the last passenger on the list is removed.

Passenger Information Page - Contact Information

- Name Fields**
 - Text fields for the "First Name" and "Last Name" of the contact person.
- Date of Birth & Contact Fields**
 - A drop down list for the month, day, and year of birth.
 1. Month list
 2. Day list
 3. Year list
 - Text fields for "Phone Number" and "Email".

Seat Selection Page



Navigation

- Progress bar updates to step 3.

Sticky Header

- Price total and passenger number updates to reflect any changes made on the last page.

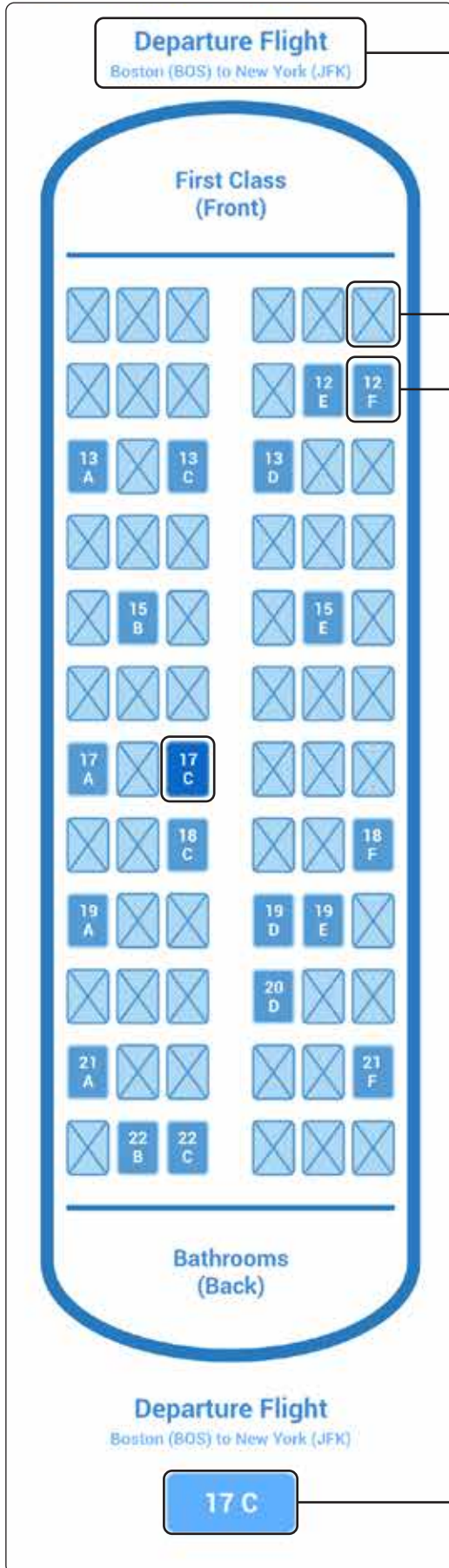
Seat Selection Interface

- Displays the available seating for each flight, and allows the user to select from available seats.
- One interface for each flight in the trip, in order of takeoff time.
- If there are more than 2 flights, add more below in rows of 2.

Continue Button

- Button is not able to be clicked until all required fields are complete.
- Once the required fields are completed, this button will darken (#70A9DC).

Seat Selection Page



Flight Title

- Top line of text displays an indicator of the flights order (Departure, Layover, 2nd Stop, or Return).
- Bottom line of text displays the airports that the user is flying between.

Unavailable Seat Icon

- If a seat is currently unavailable, the seat is marked with an "X".

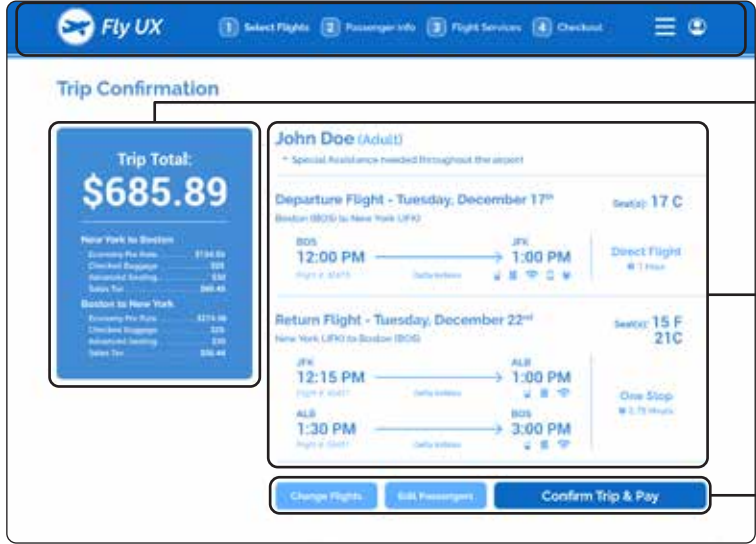
Available Seat Icon

- Any available seat is shown in #70A9DC.
- The seat letter and isle number is show inside the icon.
- Once a seat is selected, the icon color changes to #286BB4

Selected Seat

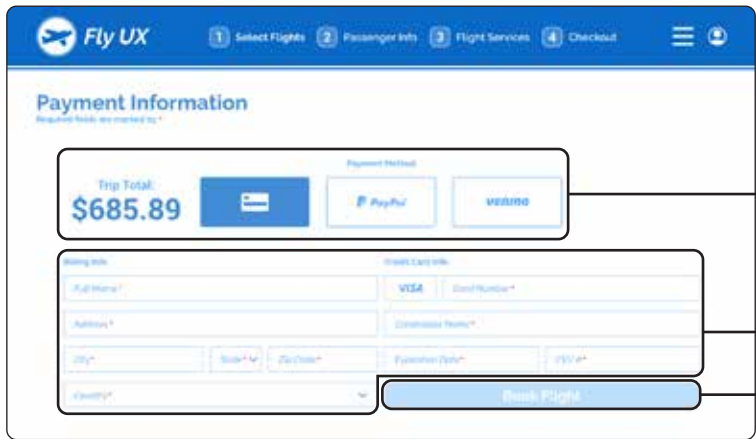
- Once a seat is selected, the seat letter and isle number are displayed in the box.

Trip Confirmation Page



- Navigation**
 - Update progress bar to step 4.
 - Remove sticky header.
- Trip Total**
 - The total cost of all flights is displayed at the top of the box.
 - The complete breakdown of charges for each individual flight is displayed below.
- Passenger & Trip Details**
 - The Name and Special Assistance for each passenger is displayed at the top.
 - The Flight Details from the Flight Selection Interface are displayed for each flight, as well as the seats selected for that passenger.
- Trip Editing & Confirmation Buttons**
 - The "Change Flights" button takes the user back to the Flight Selection Interface.
 - The "Edit Passengers" button takes the user back to the Passenger Information Page.
 - The "Confirm Trip & Pay" button takes the user to the Payment Page.

Payment Information Page



- Total & Payment Methods**
 - Defaults to a card payment.
 - If the user selects PayPal or Venmo, a pop up for the respective payment services prompts the user to log in.
 - If PayPal or Venmo is selected, the credit card form is no longer displayed, and the "Book Flight" button is highlighted once the user confirms the payment.
- Credit Card Payment Fields**
 - These fields must all be completed to book a flight with a credit card.
 - All text field except for the "State" field, which is a drop down.
- Book Flight Button**
 - Once the credit card form is complete, or the user has confirmed payment through a 3rd party payment option, the button darkens (#286BB4) allowing the user to complete the booking process.
